

Urbana Middle School Travel Basketball Information

Teams

LUYAA sponsors 4 travel basketball teams representing Urbana Middle School, playing in the Mid-Maryland Basketball League.

- Varsity – 8th grade and below.
- Junior Varsity – 7th grade and below.

Tryouts for each team will start the week of October 19th.

- **Parents are not allowed at the tryouts for any of the teams.**

Games and Schedules

The regular season will start the first weekend in December and runs through the first week of March. The boys play in 18 league games and will play in 2-3 tournaments. The girls play in 16 league games and may play in 1-2 tournaments.

Costs

A \$100 equipment fee will be collected at the parent meeting for all new players. The equipment fee is used to purchase a warm-up jacket, pants and a personalized equipment bag for each player to keep. The jacket and pants will be worn to each game. All players will participate in a Fundraising activity. There will be a minimum amount (\$100-\$150) that each player must raise. The amount will be announced at the parent meeting once the team budgets have been completed.

Eligibility

Mid-Maryland rules require that each player lives in the Urbana Middle school district. If the player does not live in the school district, please notify the Area Director or coach prior to the tryouts. All players must maintain a "C" average with no "F"s.

Parent Support

All parents will need to work at the admissions gate and concessions for up to 2 home games, depending on the schedule. Gate proceeds along with the fund-raiser are our biggest money generators to help offset the costs of the teams.

Fall Sports

During the Fall season, Fall sports will take priority over basketball practice. During the winter season and start of spring sports the travel basketball team will be the player's main sports priority. If there are conflicts, please notify the team coach.

Parent Meeting

There will be a mandatory parent meeting shortly after the tryouts have concluded. At least one parent must attend the meeting.
